All students who are enrolled for the upcoming school year will receive the Summer Simple Solutions books for Math and E.L.A. to complete over the summer break.

These books are to be completed and returned to school on the first day of the new school year. The completion of the Summer Simple Solutions Book is required and will be considered a **quiz grade for the first 9 weeks for students entering 1st – 8th grade only**. Along with the Summer Simple Solutions books, teachers encourage students to read.

The public library is a wonderful source for stories and books that students can explore. Students can also participate in their summer reading program.
